Purposes of data processing:

The purposes of data processing include, in particular, admission to the alumni community, maintaining alumni relationships, and providing information about news, events, networking activities, cooperation opportunities and other services offered by University of Technology Nuremberg.

Legal basis for data processing:

The legal basis for processing personal data for the above-mentioned purpose is consent according to Art. 6 (1) (a) and Art. 7 GDPR. Where the processing serves to maintain and promote the University's relationship with its former students, or is necessary for the performance of a public task, the processing is also carried out on the basis of Art. 6 (1) (e) GDPR in conjunction with Art. 4

BayDSG and the relevant provisions of the BayHIG. The legal basis for the processing of special categories of personal data within the meaning of Art. 9 (1) GDPR is Art. 9 (2) (a) GDPR.

Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data:

- Relevant staff of University of Technology Nuremberg, in particular the School of Students and Young Researchers (StaRs)
- Processors engaged by UTN in accordance with Art. 28 GDPR, including hosting and newsletter service providers

Transfer of personal data to a third country or international organisation:

No data will be transferred to a third country or an international organisation.

Data erasure periods or criteria for determining erasure periods:

Your personal data will be erased as soon as it is no longer necessary for the purpose for which it was collected, or if you withdraw your consent, and there are no legal retention obligations.

Information on data subject rights:

According to the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:

- If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data stored about you (Art. 15 GDPR).
- If incorrect personal data is processed, you have the right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR).
- If the legal requirements are met, you can request the erasure or restriction of processing and object to the processing (Arts. 17, 18 and 21 GDPR).
- If you have consented to data processing or if a contract for data processing exists and the data processing is carried out using automated procedures, you may have a right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR).
- If you have consented to data collection by the above-mentioned controller by means of a corresponding declaration, you can withdraw your consent at any time with future effect. This does not affect the lawfulness of data processing carried out on the basis of consent until withdrawal.

If the above rights are exercised, University of Technology Nuremberg will check whether the legal requirements for this are met.

Right of withdrawal in the case of consent:

You have the right to withdraw your declaration of consent under data protection law with regard to the processing of your personal data at any time without giving reasons. The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of data processing carried out on the basis of consent until withdrawal (Art. 7 (3) GDPR).
